We will Investigate plants and seeds in their natural environment and researching seed dispersal.	As Musicians, we will be learning how the dimensions of music work together; singing, playing, improvising and composing in pairs/group/class; using glocks and Ocarinas as tuned instruments; performing and appraising own performances.	As computer experts we will continue to learn about technology and how it is used in the wider world i.e. factories, banks, libraries.
