In Nursery we learn the names of all the different places around our immediate environment. We explore our senses both indoor and outdoors.

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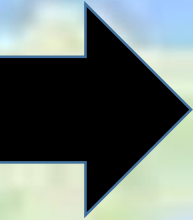
In Reception we continue learning about our immediate environment as well as our local area. We visit China to learn about Chinese New Year and then we travel to The Great Barrier Reef, where we learn lots of information about the animals that live there. The Amazon Rainforest is our last destination where we learn about the weather and the different areas such as the canopy and the forest floor.

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In Year One we take our class mascots on a tour around our village as we learn to recognise and name the landmarks around Hasland. Then we learn about the capital city of London and make comparisons between a city and a village. In our 'Wonderful World' topic we travel to Antarctica where we find out about the cold climate and blizzards! Then as a contrast we visit the continent of Africa to the Kalahari Desert. We pack our suitcases ready for the hot, dry climate!

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In Year Two we recap our learning on the local area and we explore the four capital cities of the UK and their landmarks. We learn about the Arctic and compare present day images to images from the past to make comparisons.
