School Agreement:

At Hasland Infant and Nursery School we will:

- Treat your child fairly, care for them and do our very best to ensure they are happy and safe.
- Value each child as an individual and deal sensitively with his/her needs.
- Provide a safe, secure and welcoming environment
- Ensure that your child is well educated and that they are encouraged to achieve their full potential in all aspects of school life.
- Help your child to develop a sense of responsibility and to be considerate of others
- Provide an exciting, well-balanced curriculum to meet your child's individual needs
- Be welcoming, and provide opportunities for parents/carers to become involved in the life of the school.
- Keep you informed about school matters such as your child's progress, attendance, successes and concerns.
- Hold parent and carer consultations during which your child's attainment and progress will be discussed.
- Send an annual written report about your child's achievements.
- Keep you informed about school activities through Parent Hub, newsletters and the school website.
- Carry out a safe and well-being check if you have not informed us of the reason why your child is absent. We will try and contact you up until 10 am before we carry out the visit.
- Promote the development of the children's moral and spiritual values.
- Look after the children's physical well-being during school time and will contact parents/carers if there are concerns about a child's health.
- Offer you the opportunity to become an active partner in your child's learning and school life.
- Support the children to be able to engage in age appropriate online activities and to take responsibility for keeping themselves safe online.
- Behave in a professional and respectful manner at all times.

Parent/Carer Agreement:

Whilst my/our child attends Hasland Infant and Nursery School I/we will:

- Ensure they come to school regularly (96% attendance or above), arrive on time and are ready to participate in lessons and school activities.
- Contact the school via phone or email by 10 am on the first day if they are absent for any reason.
- Ensure that all medical appointments are taken outside school hours (wherever possible) and provide evidence of these for the school's records.
- Ensure they come to school ready to learn, with all the resources/equipment they need.
- Ensure they are appropriately dressed in school uniform/PE kit, according to the school policy.
- Inform the school of any changes that may affect their child's behaviour, learning or attendance.
- Support their child by reading at least five times per week and complete any other learning activity provided by the school.
- Attend the curriculum meetings and open mornings provided for them by the school.
- Attend parent/carers consultations twice per year.
- Work with the school and other professionals in anything that requires parental involvement.
- Support all of the school policies including the behaviour policy.
- Encourage them to treat everyone within school with respect and consideration at all times.
- Ensure they behave in a kind, sensible and responsible way outside as well as inside school.
- Encourage them to become independent and look after their own things.
- Support the school in the development of their children's moral and spiritual values.
- Conduct themselves in a courteous and respectful manner towards school staff.
- Use appropriate means in which to raise concerns or ask questions.
- Follow the complaints procedure if you wish to make a complaint about the school.
- Be aware of the damaging implications of posting inappropriate comments about the school/staff/pupils/wider community on social media sites and refrain from doing so.
- Support the school's approach to online safety by not uploading any pictures, video or text that could upset, offend or threaten the safety of any members of the school community.
- Role model safe and appropriate use of technology and social media.
- Support the school in the safeguarding of children by not taking unauthorised photographs of staff/pupils.
